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### **“Living Intentionally, Purposefully & Gracefully in the Seasons of Life”**

The Psalmist asks God to “teach us to number our days that we may get a heart of wisdom.” (Psalm 90:12). None of us desire to just let the days of our life slip away. There are a number of shared experiences that we travel through in life. How can we enjoy our current season of life while preparing for the next, and honor God with our time and minister to those around us? This class will be a mixture of interviews, teaching and discussion as we challenge each other to be intentional in the seasons of life. We will consider being newly married, balancing family & career, empty nesters & grown children, grandchildren, retirement, grief in losing a child or a spouse, aging parents and end of life issues. We invite adults of all ages to join us as we seek to “look carefully how you walk, not as unwise but as wise, making the best use of the time...” (Ephesians 5:14).

### **“Thriving in Babylon”.**

We will use the video series Thriving in Babylon by Larry Osborne to examine how we can spiritually survive in an increasingly spiritually hostile environment. We will be “introduced” to Daniel who faced fears about the future, concern for his safety, and the discouragement of a world that seemed to be falling apart at warp speed. With the power of hope, humility, and wisdom, he not only survived, but thrived.

## “Genesis 1” (Room 201)

This class will seek to interpret Genesis the same way that Jesus and the writers of the New Testament understood it. It will demonstrate from both science and Scripture that the Bible is reliable, authoritative and true. It will show how Genesis builds the foundation for understanding creation, man's purpose, marriage, sin, judgment, and salvation.

Glen brings to this study his academic training as an engineer (college) and the Bible (seminary) as well a life-time of study and love for God's world (science) and God's Word (the Scripture).
